#### **PSAT INFORMATION**

This year, the Roseville Joint Union High School District is paying for all sophomores to take the PSAT – the test that allows students practice for the actual SAT. This test is very important for juniors as qualifying scores may lead to a National Merit Scholarship. If you are a freshmen or junior wishing to take the PSAT, you must sign-up and pay for the exam at our finance window or you may pay online through the student store.

The cost of the test is \$25.00. Again, if you are a sophomore, the district is paying for your test and there is no need to sign up. Please know the deadline to sign up is September 18th for freshmen and junior and there will be no late sign- ups for any reason.

If you have questions, please call Mr. Smith at ext. 6060 in the Assistant Principals' Office. All students will take the exam on Wednesday October 28th at Antelope High School and details for that day will be coming out as we get closer to exam day.
